Coastline Park Ribbon Cutting and Community Youth Day Celebration Friday, March 25 at 2:00 PM

Please join the City of Sanford as we celebrate the Grand Opening of Coastline Park in historic Goldsboro, located at 900 W. 9th Street, Sanford on March 25, 2016 at 2 PM. The park was dedicated to the City in 1977 by the Seaboard Coastline Railroad. The site served as the railroad's depot for 60 years and is also where the park's name originated from.

The new park now consists of age appropriate playground and safety surfacing, fencing and paint. The contractor also rehabbed the tennis courts, restrooms, existing pavilion and a new second pavilion was also added. The historic coquina fountain that was turned into a flower bed for many years has been rehabbed. Coastline Park is also part of the continuation of the Goldsboro Trail which now includes new lighting, basketball courts and landscaping.

The contractor was Ovation Construction, Inc. The project was funded by the City with additional funding from a state of Florida Recreational Trail Program Grant and a Florida Water Conservation Fund Grant in the amount of \$275,000. The total project cost was \$1,073,774.

Commissioner Velma Williams, District 2 invites all the kids to come out and play at this Community Youth Day Celebration at Coastline Park. There will be hot dogs and bottled water available on a first come, first serve basis. This is a great investment and asset to the historic Goldsboro community where all can enjoy this beautiful new park for generations to come.
