Sanford Police Department Selects the “Best of the Best” to Be Sanford’s School Resource Officers

There will be one Police Officer assigned to each school. There are 11 Seminole County Public Schools located in Sanford ranging from Elementary, Middle and High School. (The City of Sanford has the largest number of schools in its jurisdiction).

The School Resource Officer is an integral position in the community. The Police Officer has the unique opportunity to become a familiar, friendly face, building and strengthening the relationship between student and officer during the school day, which furthers the Department’s best practice for seamless community engagement with the youngsters and their families of the Sanford community overall.
