### SANFORD FIRE DEPARTMENT'S SMOKE ALARM PROGRAM

Due to the unfortunate tragedy of a fire related death that took place last week, through awareness and taking preventive steps, future lives can be saved. It is highly important to have a working smoke alarm with a working battery in your home. If you have that, it greatly lowers your chances of dying in a fire. As a reminder, for the past thirty five (35) years, the city has in place a smoke alarm program made available to residents.

The Sanford Fire Department will provide and install smoke detectors in your home. The City and Seminole County have partnered through a grant to obtain the smoke detectors. These are battery operated smoke detectors and are supplied free of charge for those that request them.
