Memorial Day Parade & Remembrance Ceremony Monday, May 26th 10:00 am

On Monday, May 26th the City of Sanford welcomes you to spend the morning showing appreciation to those in uniform. At 10:00 am Sanford will roll out the Red, White & Blue to salute and thank the countless veterans that have paid the ultimate price to secure our freedom, so we can all live in freedom in the United States of America.

The City of Sanford is home to more U.S. Veterans than any other City in Seminole County, Florida and was recognized as a military family friendly City. Highlights of the morning include: the Tuskegee Airmen, a helicopter flyover, a 21 gun salute, the Bahia Shriners, Military Vehicles, and Vietnam Museum.

The parade route will travel along First Street from Sanford Avenue to Park Avenue then turn north on Park Avenue arriving at the Flag in Veterans Memorial Park on the RiverWalk -- 11:00 am will be the remembrance ceremony at Veteran's Memorial Park.
