

SUBJECT: Budget Amendment – Purchase Replacement Speed Trailer

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

Unify Downtown & the Waterfront
Promote the City's Distinct Culture
Update Regulatory Framework
Redevelop and Revitalize Disadvantaged Communities

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of Resolution No. 2023-3192 amending the FY2023/2024 Capital Equipment budget by \$21,150 to purchase a replacement speed trailer is requested.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

Need a budget amendment to move an additional \$21,150 into Capital Account to complete the purchase of the replacement speed trailer.

BACKGROUND:

On May 29, 2023 the Police Department's speed trailer was struck and destroyed by a motorist. On September 25, 2023, the motorist's insurance company awarded the City of Sanford a \$10,000 claim check. On October 23, 2023 the members of the City Commission approved the acceptance of the \$10,000 insurance reimbursement via Budget Amendment Resolution No. 3165. The insurance funds are in our capital account; however, the amount is not enough to purchase the new speed trailer. We are requesting approval to move the remaining funds \$21,150 (which will be combined with the \$10,000 claim check received) from Operational Supplies and Equipment into capital account. This transfer of funds will allow us to fund the total cost of \$31, 150 for the new speed trailer.

LEGAL REVIEW:

No legal review requested of the City Attorney.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the staff's recommendation that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 23-3192 amending the FY 2023/2024 Capital Budget in support of procuring a replacement speed trailer.

SUGGESTED MOTION:

Resolution No.2023-3192

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and

terminating on September 30, 2024 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
