Resolution No. 2825

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and terminating on September 30, 2019 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and terminating on September 30, 2019 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and

terminating on September 30, 2019 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

SYNOPSIS:

Budget amendments have been prepared which will increase expenditures in the General Fund, Law Enforcement Trust Fund, Catalyst Site Fund, and the Mayfair Fund. The budget amendment will decrease expenditures in the Local Option Gas Tax Fund, CRA Fund, and the Cemetery Fund.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

The proposed budget amendment will increase the FY 2019 Citywide budget by \$1,581,667.

BACKGROUND:

The attached budget amendment is for the following:

- 1. **GENERAL FUND** A \$858,956 increase to the General Fund budget due to a transfer to the Mayfair Fund and the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to cover operating and capital expenditures in excess of revenue.
- 2. <u>SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS</u> An overall \$913,427 decrease to the Special Revenue Funds of which \$840,800 is to true up a transfer error in the Local Option Gas Tax Fund, \$51,949 is to true up the CRA to the actual reserve balance, and \$29,723 is to true up the Cemetery Fund to the actual reserve balance. These decreases are offset by an increase to the Law Enforcement Trust Fund of \$9,045 to cover costs in excess of expenditures.
- 3. <u>CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS</u> A \$725,527 increase to the Special Revenue Funds for a transfer from the CRA for the Catalyst street projects.

4. **ENTERPRISE FUNDS** A \$910,611 increase to the Enterprise Funds to cover expenditures in excess of revenue in the Mayfair Fund and transfer the capital allocation for capital repairs and replacements.

LEGAL REVIEW:

No legal review requested of the City Attorney.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is staff's recommendation that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 2825 amending the FY 2019 budget by \$1,581,667.
