Resolution No. 2022-3005

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022 pertaining to the award of a 2021 American Automobile Association (AAA) Florida Traffic Safety Grant Program grant to the Police Department; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision such as pertaining to the award of a 2021 American Automobile Association (AAA) Florida Traffic Safety Grant Program grant to the Police Department; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment; Award of a 2021 AAA Florida Traffic Safety Grant Program grant to Police Department.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A" pertaining to the pertaining to the award of a 2021 AAA Florida Traffic Safety Grant Program grant to the Police Department. The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to included, but not be limited to, the expenditure of funds deriving from o the award of a 2021 AAA Florida Traffic Safety Grant Program grant to the Police Department..

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of Resolution No. 3005 to amend the budget addressing the American Automobile Association (AAA) Grant award funds.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

The Police Department was awarded a AAA grant. The total grant award is in the amount of, \$14,000.

BACKGROUND:

The Police Department applied for the 2021 AAA Florida Traffic Safety Grant Program and was successfully awarded. The area of focus for this grant is Slow Down Move Over, Driver Education. The grant funds are intended to be used to purchase ticket printers and light-emitting diode (LED) flairs. The use of the flairs will assist in protecting the public as well as law enforcement officers and public safety workers in emergency situations.

For over 100 years, AAA has worked with schools, first responders and other organizations to keep communities safe. Traffic safety has been a focus of the AAA program by providing law enforcement agencies, schools, first responders and nonprofit organizations to work with AAA in attaining its goal of reducing traffic injuries and fatalities on Florida roadways. Grant requests were limited to \$15,000 per grantee.

LEGAL REVIEW:

The Assistant City Attorney has reviewed the proposed action and has no legal objection.

RECOMMENDATION:

City staff recommends that City Commission approve the proposed Resolution No. 2021-3005 to amend the budget in the amount of, \$14,000 and implement the proposed action.
