Resolution No. 3042

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and

terminating on September 30, 2022 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

Unify Downtown & the Waterfront
Promote the City's Distinct Culture
Update Regulatory Framework
Redevelop and Revitalize Disadvantaged Communities

SYNOPSIS:

Approve the Resolution No. 3042 to amend the budget in association with the previously approved Resolution No. 2021 - 2937 the Peace and Justice Institute (PJI) at Valencia College to provide technical assistance, training and facilitation services for the Advisory Committee to produce a report with findings and recommendations.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

The budgetary impact to the City associated with the creation of the proposed Race, Equality, Equity and Inclusion Advisory Committee will not exceed \$35,000. Some City staff time will need to be devoted to working with the facilitators and Advisory Committee regarding collection and vetting applications, coordinating meeting time and location and planning meetings with facilitators.

BACKGROUND:

Resolutions No 2021 – 2937 authorizing the creation of the Race, Equality, Equity and Inclusion Advisory Committee and Resolution No. 2021 – 2938 authorizing the transfer of \$35,000 from the City Reserve to the Community Relations and Neighborhood Engagement budget was approved by the City Commission at the February 22, 2021 meeting to support the project. The agreement with the Peace and Justice Institute (PJI) at Valencia College was executed September 15, 2021 and the first meeting of the Advisory Committee was held October 19, 2021. The Peace and Justice Institute has provided services that include facilitating bi-monthly REEI committee meetings, training session for the committee on race, equity, and inclusion, racial wealth gap simulation exercise and a series of (3) three Sanford Speaks events. The final task for PJI is to facilitate the Advisory Committee's creation of a written report containing recommendations for the City Commission.

The Budget transfer of the \$35,000 was implemented in the 2021 Budget year which ended September 30, 2021 and not rolled over to the 2022 Budget year that started October 1, 2021. The \$35,000 transfer is the reallocation of funds previously approved by the City Commission and allocated for the Race, Equality, Equity and Inclusion project.

The City Attorney drafted approved Resolution(s).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 3042 to amend the budget, in the amount of, \$35,000 for technical assistance, facilitators and administrative cost associated with Resolution No. 2021 - 2937
