

## Resolution No. 2024-3255

**A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024 relating to funding for State Road 46 utilities adjustments; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.**

**Whereas**, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

**Whereas**, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

**Whereas**, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision such as funding for State Road 46 utilities adjustments; and

**Whereas**, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

**Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:**

### **Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment; Funding for State Road 46 Utilities Adjustments.**

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A" relating to funding for State Road 46 utilities adjustments.

The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.**

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to implement the funding for **State Road 46** utilities adjustments.

**Section 3. Savings.**

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities pertaining to funding for State Road 46 utilities adjustments funding are hereby ratified and affirmed.

**Section 4. Conflicts.**

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. Severability.**

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

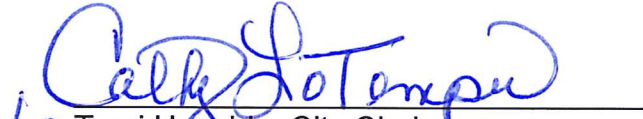
**Section 6. Effective Date.**


This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

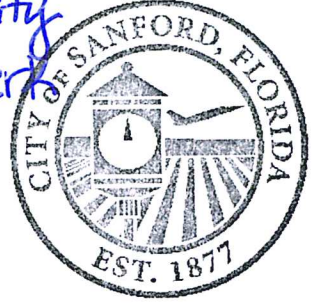

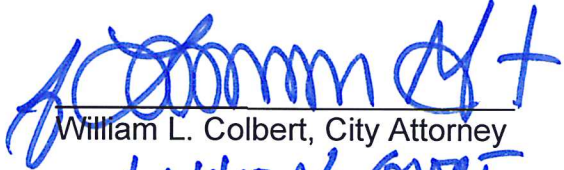

**SYNOPSIS:**

Approval of Resolution No. 2024-3255, amending the budget in the amount of \$767,642 and award of bid IFB 23/24-16 in the total amount of \$2,367,642, is requested by the City Commission.

**FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:**

The total expenditure in the amount of \$2,367,642 in which funding is available from the Utilities Capital account line.

**BACKGROUND:**

The State Road 46 utilities adjustment project includes:

- a) Locate 20 LF of unknown size NPW main under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing NPW main.
- b) Installation of 192 LF 8" PVC WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing WM.
- c) 20 LF of vertical deflection of unknown NPW main under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing NPW main.
- d) Locate and protect or adjust 20 LF of vertical deflection of 10" PVC WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing NPW main.
- e) Locate and protect 20 LF of vertical deflection of 4" HDPE NPW main under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing NPW main.
- f) Locate and Protect existing 16" NPW main with stainless steel split casing.
- g) 30 LF of vertical deflection of 12" WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing WM.
- h) Installation of 120 LF 8" PVC WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing WM.
- i) Removal of 120 LF 2" WM.

- j) Installation of 60 LF 8” PVC WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing WM.
- k) Installation of 100 LF 8” PVC WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing WM.
- l) Installation of 100 LF 16” PVC WM under proposed storm drain and removal of associated existing WM.
  - i. Adjustment of two (2) manhole covers to final grade.
  - ii. Adjustment of 4 valve covers to final grade.
  - iii. Approximately 100 SY of asphalt repair.
  - iv. Mill and Overlay 200 SY of asphalt.

The project was competitively bid with the following bids being received:

Central Florida Environmental Corporation:	\$3,312,193
