Resolution No. 2024-3259

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024 relating to funding of the Public Art Commission by the Community Redevelopment Agency for public art projects; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and such as funding of the Public Art Commission by the Community Redevelopment Agency for public art projects; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment; Funding of the Public Art Commission by the Community Redevelopment Agency For Public Art Projects.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning

October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A" for funding of the Public Art Commission by the Community Redevelopment Agency for public art projects. The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing Administrative Actions; Funding of the Public Art Commission by the Community Redevelopment Agency For Public Art Projects.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to implement the funding of the Public Art Commission by the Community Redevelopment Agency for public art projects.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities to include, but not limited to, those relating to operations of the Public Art Commission and City public art projects, are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to

invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.



SYNOPSIS:

Approval of Resolution No. 2024-3259, relating to funding of the Public Art Commission (PAC) by the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) for two public art projects is requested.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

The funding provided by the CRA to the PAC, totaling \$69,380, will provide for the funding of beneficial public art programs.

BACKGROUND:

The public art projects are the subject of the attached Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) which, were fully executed on June 11, 2024, after the CRA authorized the funding of the projects at a prior CRA meeting.

One MOU funds the PAC for public artwork from Leopold Gallery, LLC, a Missouri limited-liability company, in the sum of \$15,980. The public artwork is depicted in an exhibit to the attached Public Art Purchase, Acceptance And Release Agreement.

The other MOU funds the PAC for public artwork from BB Murals LLC, a Maryland limited-liability company, in the sum of \$53,400. The public artwork is depicted in an exhibit to the attached Public Art Purchase, Acceptance And Release Agreement.

The City Attorney's office has assisted in this matter and has no legal objection to the action proposed.
