

Resolution No. 2024-3274

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024 relating to infrastructure funding; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision such as for infrastructure funding; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment; Infrastructure Funding.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A" relating to infrastructure funding. The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year

beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to implement the funding of infrastructure projects.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities pertaining to infrastructure projects are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

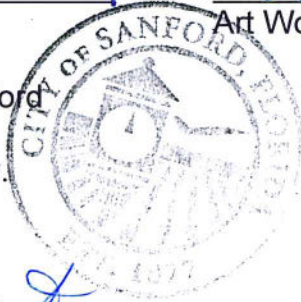

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

- Unify Downtown & the Waterfront
- Promote the City’s Distinct Culture
- Update Regulatory Framework
- Redevelop and Revitalize Disadvantaged Communities

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of Resolution No. 2024-3274, amending the budget from multiple utility accounts to redistribute the funds from previously allocated projects that will not be completed in this fiscal year to projects that will be completed in FY 2024/2025 is requested.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

Funds in the amount of \$1,880,000 are available in various Utility Capital Accounts.

BACKGROUND:

The Utility Division proposes to amend the City budget to reallocate funds to a Utility Capital Impact Fee Account from reserves to complete the proposed project. Several Infrastructure Projects are proposed that will enable the City to install new upsized water mains, new water mains, and ancillary items related to the upsized and new mains to meet mandatory guidelines with respect to acceptable water pressure and availability.

As part of the budget Amendment the Utility Department will be redistributing funds from the below projects:

- AMR Meter Replacement - \$250,000
- WTP#3 SSWRC - \$940,000
- AMI Meters - \$250,000
- Water impact fees - \$440,000

The projects that will be funded for FY 2024/2025 would include:

- Riverview upsizing project - \$200,000
- Kentucky St upsizing project - \$500,000
- Pine Way new infrastructure project - \$1,180,000

LEGAL REVIEW:

The Assistant City Attorney has assisted in this matter and has no legal objection to the action.

RECOMMENDATION:

City staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 2024-3274, amending the City budget, in the amount of \$1,880,000 to redistribute the Utility Capital Accounts.
