## GARBAGE & RECYCLING 407-688-5089

### ALL MATERIALS MUST BE CURBSIDE NO LATER THAN 7:00 A.M. FOR COLLECTION

Refuse Service is mandatory for residential and commercial properties.

### Residential Curbside/Alley Service

Garbage ..... Twice Weekly  
Recycling ..... Once Weekly  
Yard Waste ..... Once Weekly

### Household Garbage

An unlimited amount of mixed household garbage may be placed out for collection in 40-gallon watertight receptacles consisting of either plastic, metal, rubber or any other similar material provided with proper handles and a tight-fitting cover or 40-gallon bags. Bags or containers can weigh no more than 50 pounds each when full. The hauler will leave behind containers exceeding the 40-gallon / 50 pound limit or garbage mixed with yard waste or special waste. A tag indicating the reason will be left.

### Special Bulk Material

Every April and October, residents are scheduled for one FREE special pickup of bulk material that is not practical to bag or bundle and tie, including yard waste and other acceptable

homeowner generated non-hazardous materials. Bulk material generated at any time other than the scheduled April and October free pickup will be at an additional cost, with a 4 cubic yard minimum, please call Public Works Solid Waste Division for pricing. The collection schedule for this service is provided every Thursday or Friday depending on location with prior notification to the Public Works Solid Waste Division at 407-688-5089.

### Yard Waste Debris

An unlimited amount of yard waste may be placed out for collection in any combination of either 40-gallon receptacles consisting of either plastic, metal, rubber or any other similar material provided with proper handles, 40-gallon bags, or tied bundles. Bundles can be no longer than five (5) feet or contain branches larger than five (5) inches in diameter. Bags, bundles, or containers can weigh no more than 50 pounds each when full. The hauler will leave behind items exceeding the 40-gallon / 50 pound limit, bundles exceeding the 5 foot / 5 inch limit, bundles not tied or yard waste mixed with household garbage or special waste. A tag indicating the reason will be left. Yard waste is picked up on Wednesdays. Yard Waste is vegetative matter resulting from the yard and landscaping maintenance of your own property. This includes material such as tree branches, leaves, grass clippings or palm fronds.

### Recyclable Material

The following materials ARE accepted in the curbside recycle program: Pasteboard (i.e., cereal boxes, empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls, soda boxes, beer boxes, tissue boxes, gift boxes, clean pizza boxes and shoe boxes), Brown paper grocery bags (no wax, no wet strength material, no liners), Corrugated cardboard (flattened and cut down to fit inside the recycle bin), Newspapers, supplements, magazines, catalogs and telephone books, Plastic containers #1-7 (#'s on bottom of containers), Glass bottles and jars (clear, green and brown), Aluminum cans, Steel cans such as food cans.

*Please rinse out all containers and discard all lids.*

### Hazardous Household Waste

Items such as: Antifreeze, Fluorescent Lamps, Gasoline, Rechargeable Batteries, Paint, Poisons, Used Oil Filters, Propane Tanks, Pool & Lawn Chemicals, Solvents – Thinners, Thermometers (Mercury), Aerosols, Used Motor Oil, Thermostats, Automotive Batteries and Pesticides can be disposed of at the Seminole County Transfer Station. *Containers must be clearly labeled stating the contents.*
