

Resolution No. 3448

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and terminating on September 30, 2026 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and terminating on September 30, 2026 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and

terminating on September 30, 2026 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

SYNOPSIS:

Requesting to approve Resolution No. 3448 to amend the capital budget in the amount of \$16,535 for the procurement of kitchen remodel for Fire Department Stations 32 and 38.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

Funding is available using Capital Machinery and Equipment funds once the FY2025 capital funds are rolled over to FY2026. The rolling over of the FY2025 capital funds is scheduled for approval at the January 26th City Commission meeting.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Department was approved \$30,000 capital funds to remodel the kitchens at Stations 32 and 38. As a result of IRFQ 34/35-310 Fire Department Stations 32 and 38 Kitchen Remodels bidding process, the lowest responsive bid was \$46,535 which exceeds the project's current funds in the amount of \$16,353.

LEGAL REVIEW:

The City Attorney has reviewed this agenda item and has no legal objection, provided that the City's procurement and purchasing policies were adhered to.

RECOMMENDATION:

City Staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 3448 to amend the budget for the procurement of kitchen remodels for Fire Department stations 32 and 38 in the amount of \$16,535.
